

2. Possibilities of Approaching and Observing the Airfield

The airfield is located in the Neuhardenberg Forst and is rainly surrounded by wood. The landing field can be seen from the Neuhardenberg-Quappenderf road of which the northern portion is blocked. It is unknown to what extent the road is still open for traffic. The housing area southwest of Neuhardenberg-Altfriedland road can possibly be observed from the adjacent paths dividing forest districts. The cantonment in Jagen (forest district No 139) is not restricted. Guarding facilities are not known. The airfield is surrounded by a wire fence except for that section which is bordered by Kietzer Lake. The housing area is surrounded by a 1.8 meter-high wooden fence.
