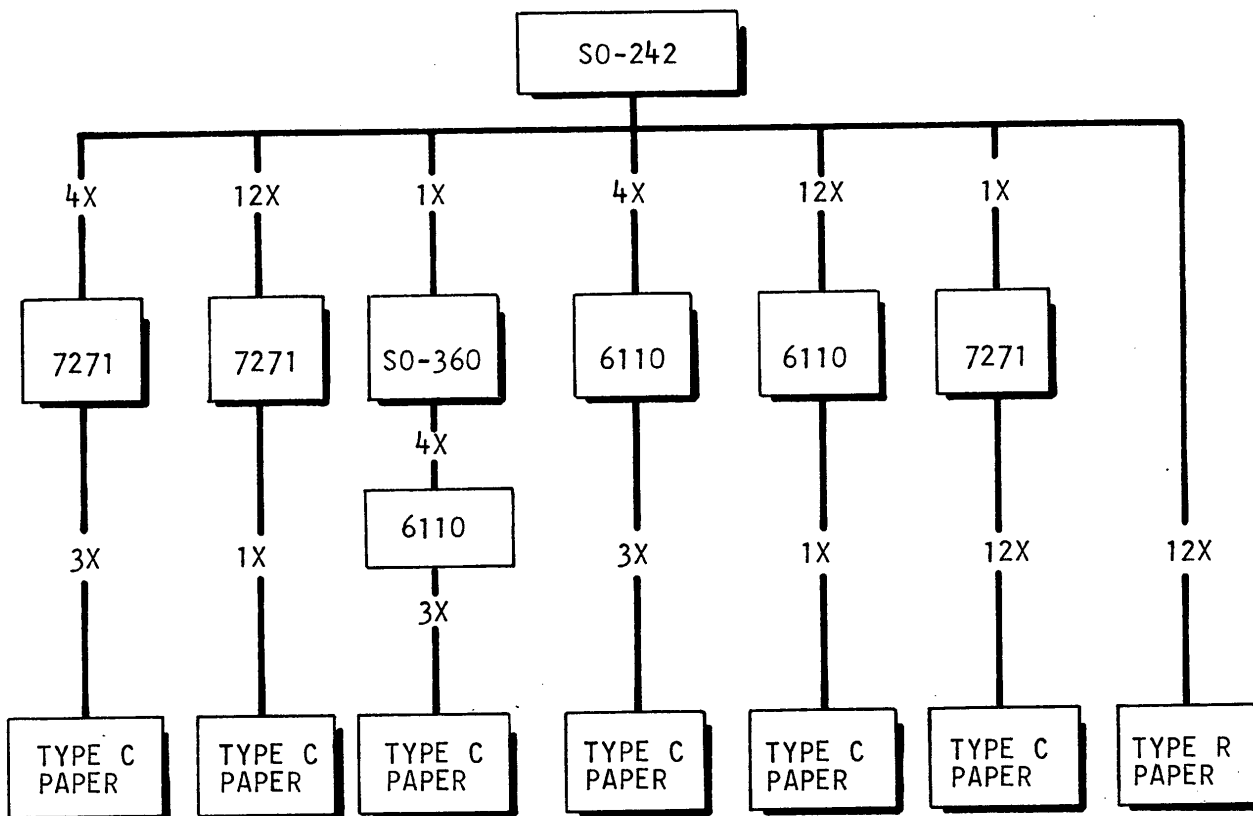

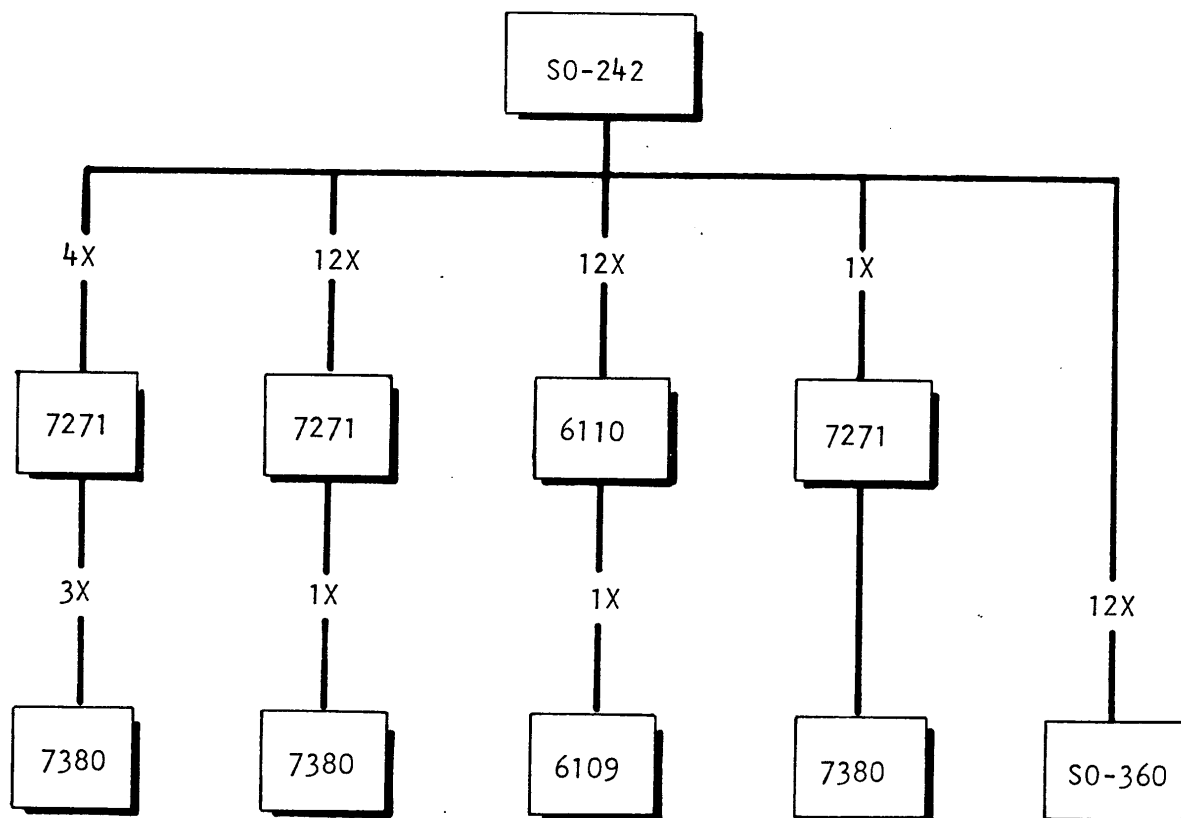

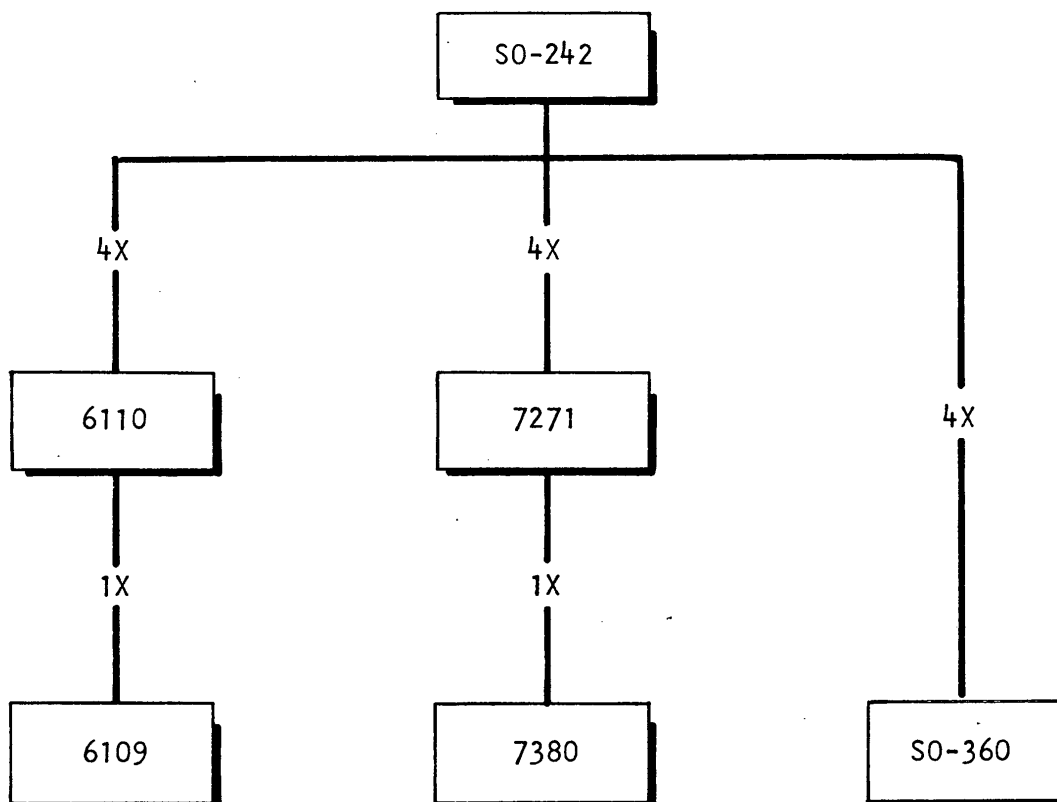

2. ☐ SHOULD INCLUDE AN IN-FLIGHT CHANGEABLE FILTER AND MATERIAL CHANGE DETECTOR BY FLIGHT UNIT # 7.
3. CONSIDERATION SHOULD BE GIVEN TO BUILDING AN APOCHROMAT PETZVAL FOR AT LEAST ONE D-3 or IRIS II SYSTEM.
4. NPIC SHOULD UNDERTAKE A PROGRAM TO STANDARDIZE COLOR DEFINITIONS and TERMINOLOGY.

6. PRESSURE ON E. K. SHOULD BE MAINTAINED TO PUT SO-242 ON UTB AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
7. NPIC/EXRAND SHOULD UNDERTAKE A PROGRAM TO ESTABLISH THE REQUIREMENTS FOR STANDARDIZING PI EXPLOITATION EQUIPMENT FOR COLOR UTILIZATION.

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

1. LIMITED operational COLOR TESTING on all ALL SYSTEMS should be continued.
2. COLLECTION should be AIMED AT ALL TARGET CATEGORIES until a sufficient data base has been obtained.
3. AIRCRAFT COLLECTION AGAINST (and analysis of) DOMESTIC TARGETS should be continued.
4. The life of the COLOR TASK FORCE should be extended for six months.
5. The AGENCY COLOR REQUIREMENTS WORKING GROUP should be formalized for at least six months.
6. Future PHOTO/OPTICAL SYSTEMS should be designed to allow USE of COLOR.
7. Consideration should be given in both CIA and DIA of making it a REQUIREMENT that, as much as possible, COVERT PHOTO COLLECTION be done in COLOR.

CONCLUSIONS

1. The quality of SO-242 [REDACTED] is sufficiently high that RESOLUTION is NO LONGER a MAJOR QUESTION relative to the use of COLOR.
2. A moderate program should be undertaken to increase the color capability of both national processing centers
3. The quality of SO-242 on MISSION 1108 was NOT OPTIMUM and further study is warranted.
4. COLOR DOES PROVIDE INFORMATION that BLACK and WHITE DOES NOT, both UNIQUELY and AUXILIARY.
5. There exists a significant variance in capability to handle COLOR within the exploitation community, although all users can handle COLOR.
6. There are indications that duplication processes can be manipulated to produce HIGH RESOLUTION BLACK & WHITE duplicates from the ORIGINAL COLOR.
