SAN CRISTOBAL MRBM SITE #3 WAS OBSERVED ON SECOND OBLIQUE EARTH PHOTOGRAPHY BY BRASS KNOB SCARRING FOR ONE PROBABLE LAUNCH POSITION, NINE BARRACKS/SUPPORT BUILDINGS, 2 MEDIUM SOVIET TENTS, AND APPROXIMATELY 15 UNIDENTIFIED VEHICLES. THE TWO 6-GUN AAA SITES SITES LOCATED JUST EAST AND WEST OF THE AREA ARE PROBABLY OCCUPIED.

2. GUANAJAY IRBM SITES 1 AND 2 WERE OBSERVED ON SECOND OBLIQUE PHOTOGRAPHY BY BRASS KNOB

SITE 1 -- EARTH SCARRING FOR 4 LAUNCH POSITIONS AND 2 CONTROL AREAS ARE APPARENT. NO VEHICLES OR MILITARY EQUIPMENT ARE DISCERNABLE.

SITE 2 -- EARTH SCARRING FOR 4 LAUNCH POSITIONS AND 2 CONTROL AREAS ARE APPARENT. NO VEHICLES OR MILITARY EQUIPMENT ARE DISCERNABLE.

AN EARTH COVERED DRIVE-THROUGH STRUCTURE APPEARS COMPLETE. A CONVOY OF APPROXIMATELY 20 UNIDENTIFIED VEHICLES IS ENTERING THE AREA WITH NUMEROUS OTHER VEHICLES OBSERVED IN THE PARKING AREA WEST OF THE BUNKER.
