SOUTH VIETNAM/CAMBODIA BORDER AREA

1. TROJAN HORSE [REDACTED] REVEALS TWO

AREAS ALONG THE SOUTH VIETNAM/CAMBODIA BORDER, IN THE VICINITY OF THE MEKONG RIVER, WHICH ARE POSSIBLY ASSOCIATED WITH INSURGENT ACTIVITY.

2. THE FIRST AREA, LOCATED AT 1053N-10515E (UTM WT282044) 3.5 NM EAST OF BEN DINH, SOUTH VIETNAM, CONTAINS EXTENSIVE TRENCHING ALONG THE SOUTHERN BANK OF THE RACH SO THUONG (RIVER) IN SOUTH VIETNAM PARALLEL TO THE BORDER, AND AN ABANDONED STRONGPOINT ADJACENT TO THE BORDER. A FORTIFIED POSITION IS LOCATED IN CAMBODIA JUST WITHIN THE BORDER, CONTAINING EXTENSIVE PERIMETER FOXHOLES AND WEAPONS EMPLACEMENTS AND CONNECTED TO SOUTH VIETNAM BY A TRAIL.

3. THE SECOND AREA, LOCATED AT 1056N-10530E (UTM WT551102) JUST SOUTHWEST OF THONG BINH, CAMBODIA, CONTAINS EXTENSIVE TRENCHING ALONG THE EASTERN BANK OF THE RACH CAI CO (RIVER) IN SOUTH VIETNAM AND AN ABANDONED STRONGPOINT ADJACENT TO THE BORDER. TRAILS ARE OBSERVED IN THE VICINITY EXTENDING ACROSS THE BORDER.
