3. TARGET DESCRIPTION:

QUI NHON COMPLEX, LOCATED ON THE COAST OF CENTRAL SOUTH VIETNAM, IS A DEEP-WATER PORT, WITH AN ESTIMATED POPULATION OF 37,700 (1963). IT IS THE CAPITAL OF TINH BINH DINH PROVINCE, AND ALSO THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE 1ST US LOGISTICAL COMMAND IN SOUTH VIETNAM.

4. EVALUATION:

THE COLOR IS SOME OF THE BEST OF THE MISSION.
