- A. TWO DEFENDED VILLAGES ARE OBSERVED APPROXIMATELY THREE NM NORTHEAST OF THE LAOS/NORTH VIETNAM BORDER NEAR ROUTE 137. THE VILLAGE OF BAN KATOI, CONTAINING TWO PERSONNEL TRENCHES, IS LOCATED AT 1721N 10611E (UTM XE261194). AN UNNAMED VILLAGE CONTAINING TWO PERSONNEL TRENCHES AND FOUR AW/AA POSITIONS IS LOCATED AT 1720N 10611E (UTM XE267178). PERSONNEL TRENCHES WITH A TOTAL OF TWELVE AW/AA POSITIONS AT UTM XE272181, UTM XE274180, AND UTM XE278178, ARE LOCATED ALONG A TRAIL CONNECTING THE VILLAGES WITH ROUTE 137.
- TWO AREAS CONTAINING SIX AW/AA POSITIONS WITH AN INTER-CONNECTING TRENCH SYSTEM ARE LOCATED EAST OF ROUTE 137 AT 1718N 10612E (UTM XE283146 AND UTM XE285142). ALSO WITHIN THIS AREA REVEALED ONE CAMOUFLAGED PROBABLE


