1. OGC RESPONSE ~~TALKING PAPER~~ TO TOPIC NO. VI

This paper, which concerns legislative proposals to protect rights of US citizens, was distributed at 5 December meeting.

- c. ICS proposes that "core activities" section of paper be given to Church and Pike with covering DCI letter. Draft of proposed letter will be distributed at meeting. [Redacted] has prepared listing of pros and cons for this action, which should be discussed at the meeting. The letter and its enclosure could be given Church at 11 December hearing and to Pike at 12 December hearing.
