1. Base fuel depots, where bulk supplies are concentrated prior to distribution to regional stations, are located in Ruse and Svishtov.
2. Regional fuel depots are located near the following villages:
 - a. Gorublyane (N 42-38; E 23-25) about 6 kilometers east of Sofia, some 2 kilometers south of Iskur (gara);
 - b. Sarantsi (N 42-43; E 23-47) about 36 kilometers east of Sofia on the road to Botevgrad;
 - c. Makotsevo (N 42-42; E 23-48) about 40 kilometers east of Sofia on the road to Pirdop; and
 - d. Doyrentsi (N 43-14; E 24-50) about 15 kilometers northeast of Lovech, on the road to Svishtov.
3. The Sofia okrug reportedly accounts for approximately 72 percent of the total Bulgarian fuel consumption.
