SUBJECT: Authorization for Language Lessons

1. It is requested that authorization be granted to permit the following employees at the [redacted] station to take Spanish lessons at Government expense: [redacted]

2. In accordance with a memorandum to all Foreign Division Chiefs dated 27 April 1949, it has been determined in this case:

- a. That the employee should receive this training under secure circumstances for reasons of immediate operational necessity;
- b. That the cost to the Government will not exceed \$ 250.00 during any fiscal year for each employee; and
- c. That such language lessons will directly benefit the Government.

3. It is believed that this request is justified by the advantages that will accrue to the [redacted] station because of the above employees' study of the Spanish language.
