- 1. The VEB Wärmetechnik, Oresden, manufactured five spot-welding machines in November 1953. Two of the machines, without electrodes, were delimined to Grechoslavakin; one went to the VVB works in Schwerin (Friedrichstrasse 5-7); the other two were delivered to the Soviet Union.
- In November, 52 fuel flowmeters with a capacity of 1,500 litera per hour work delivered to the Soviet Union.
- 3. About 30 hydraulic pumps for rockets were manufactured and delivered to the limitation. The Kabelwerk Oberspree in Berlin furnished parts for these pumps.
