1. The AAA section at Nagykoros is established in the barracks on the road to Kecskemet, about one km. south of the town. It has an air observation and information platoon, a quartermaster platoon and three batteries. The strength is about 450 men. The 1st and 2nd Batteries are armed with four 37 mm machine cannon each, the 3rd Battery with six 85 mm guns.
2. The auto park includes four passenger cars, 16 Csepel 3-ton trucks, six Weapon tractors, five jeeps, one radio car and seven motorcycles.
3. Commander of the 1st Battery is Lt. [redacted] Galambos, about 25 years old.
4. In addition to fire training the men take heavy skirmisher training twice a week in the woods as infantry. During night exercises the section has the use of four large searchlights, 150 cm in diameter.
5. During the summer of 1953 reservists were trained on Soviet materiel. About 150 reservists were taken in on 1 May 53. Two extra 37 mm guns, not belonging to the batteries, were provided for the purpose.
