1. On 16 Feb 54 there was a meeting of Communist Chinese representatives in the East Zone under the Ambassador Tshi Peng-fai, in the hotel Johannisbor.
2. The meeting took up the question of the Four Power Conference and Molotov's efforts in behalf of Communist China. Most of the Chinese criticized Molotov vehemently, and as a result no more such meetings were held. The speakers of this group said that the USSR had no real intention of improving the position of China. They evidenced the fact that Molotov obtained some results for the USSR, but got nowhere in his requests for China.
