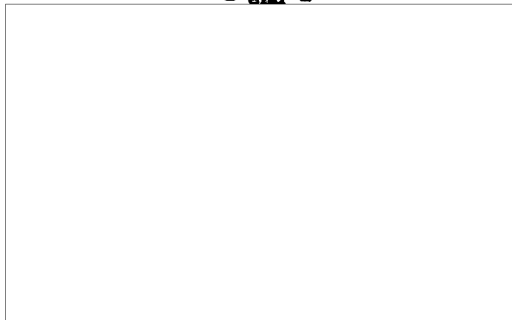

1. A train of 45 cars loaded with cannon left Czechoslovakia on 28 Apr 54. The ostensible destination was Kielce, Poland, but the guns are believed to be intended for China or Korea.
2. The shipment comprised eight 105 mm. guns with long barrels, muzzle brakes, and 4-wheeled carriages; 11 antitank guns about 80 mm. caliber; and about 20 guns of about 75 mm. caliber with barrels about 1.2 meters long and 2-wheeled carriages designed to be served and moved by two men.
