SUBJECT : Presidential Briefings

1. The slippage of the Africa NSC Meeting to at least Friday, 6 October, and probably even later means that my earlier proposal for topics for a 3 October briefing should be scrapped. I recommend you plan to cover:

--Panamanian Foreign Policy. [] briefing is attached. 25X1

--Soviet/Cuban Options in Rhodesia. The briefing package is attached.

-- [] This is good for 3 October only if you want to drop Dr. Perry's participation. If you want him to participate we should slip this to 17 October.
