
Dear Mr. Wilson:

Enclosed you will find copies of correspondence regarding my 1977 Freedom of Information request to your office, and your reply to me.

Your reply states, "We have searched those Agency systems that might contain information regarding your deceased brother and find that we have found no information that pertains to Lt. Paul Whipkey."

After reviewing files and records obtained from other Government Agencies via the Freedom of Information Act, I have been advised to contact your Agency again under the Freedom of Information Act Statutes, requesting that your Agency provide any and all information you may have regarding Lieutenant Paul B. Whipkey, starting from 1950 to the present.

This time, it is requested that you check all of your files and systems for any information whatever pertaining to Lieutenant Paul B. Whipkey, and not limit your search to systems that "might" contain information regarding Paul B. Whipkey.

Also, check your 201 files for the name of Paul B. Whipkey or Paul B. Whipper. If either name is in your 201 files or any other file in your Agency, please notify me immediately.

Furthermore, it is requested that you check your Agency's application for employment records and "Contracts," signed for employment with your Agency and report to me if the name of Paul B. Whipkey or Paul B. Whipper is in either of these files.

Also, please check all of your files pertaining to the names of CIA personnel who died while in the employment of your Agency. If the name of Paul B. Whipkey or Paul B. Whipper is in these files, please notify me.

Your cooperation and compliance with this Freedom of Information letter will be greatly appreciated.

[redacted] disappeared July 11, 1958, from his base at Company C., 547 Engineer Battalion, Fort Ord, California. As Administrator of the Estate of Lieutenant Paul B. Whipkey, I am requesting your office to initiate on my behalf all rights available under The Privacy Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-579), also referred to the Freedom of Information Act.

Please request of the CIA, Gene F. Wilson Information and Privacy Coordinator CIA, Washington, D. C. 20505, any information in their files pertaining to Lieutenant Paul B. Whipkey. Including but not limited to any investigation by that department relating to his disappearance on July 11, 1958; any record that department may have of Lieutenant Whipkey's involvement or contact at any time with the CIA, whether as a member of the Armed Forces or civilian. It is the intent of this request to secure, in full detail, any information relating to Lieutenant Paul B. Whipkey.
