#### RESTRICTION

Sec. 25 - International Security Assistance Act of 1977

FY 1978 Foreign Assistance and Related Programs Appropriations Act

Sec. 503 - Foreign Assistance and Related Programs Appropriations Act (Brooke Amendment)

#### EFFECT

Prohibits assistance in FY 1978 for military or paramilitary operations in Zaire unless . President determines such assistance is in the national security interests and submits a description and certification to Congress

Prohibits assistance of any kind to promote military or paramilitary operations in Angola

Prohibits non-intelligence covert operation abroad by CTA unless President finds it is important to national security and reports it to Congress

Prohibits military assistance, training, foreign military sales or financing, and Munitions Control export licenses for Argentina after September 30, 1978

Prohibits, with respect to Chile, the same activities prohibited for Argentina by Sec. 620B of of the FAA (described above).

Prohibits the use of funds for a number of countries in Latin America and Africa

Prohibits assistance to a country in default for more than one year in repayment of a loan from the U.S. unless previously disputed or default being cured.

Prohibit grant military assistance to any country unless the country and the amount of assis ance are specified by law. (The precludes immediate grant assistance to a country not specifically included in the annual authorization bill.)
