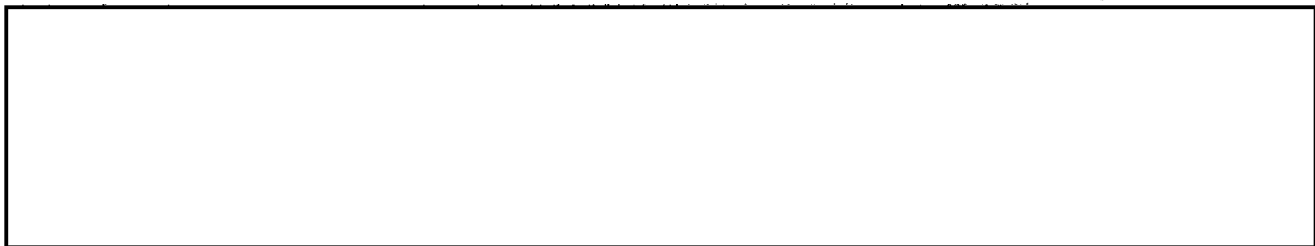

11. I told them of my concern with the [redacted] case. They were partly familiar with it. They agreed that we should stand together on this one. They weren't ready to be sure they were going to take a position against [redacted] having a clearance though they seemed inclined in that direction. I will hold my letter further until I hear from them that they are willing to stand with us.
