15. SUMMARY: 1. [Redacted] This report describes U/I flying objects observed by Source, in July 1967. These objects were flying in a southwesterly direction near CHOMUTOV. They had a visible smoke trail not a condensation trail. They were of cylindrical shape without wings. He estimated their flight to be at an altitude of 15,000 to 20,000 m. The firing of the UFOs was conducted during the month of July 1967, with two to three firings per week in good weather. The firings were conducted regularly around 2100 hrs, at a rate of three to four. The sound of the firing came from an easterly direction, turned to a southwesterly direction, and then at quite a distance from West Germany. The UFOs would go in the direction of East Germany. Due to sudden changes of direction, Source assumes the UFOs to be remote controlled.	(Leave Blank)
