1. The Georgian Coal Mine Construction Administration (GruzShakhtoStroy) was organized in the early thirties to centralize and supervise construction and expansion of coal mines in the Georgian SSR. The administrative offices of GruzShakhtoStroy were at 12 Spusk Elbakidze in Tbilisi. GruzShakhtoStroy was directly subordinate to the All-Union Ministry of Coal Mining Industry, Chief Directorate for Building of Fuel Producing Enterprises (Glavnoye upravleniye stroitel'stva toplivnykh predpriyatiy).
2. The Georgian Coal Mine Construction Administration had three regional ShakhtoStroy agencies:
  - a. The Tkvibuli ShakhtoStroy attached to the Tkvibuli Coal Mine Trust
  - b. The Tkvarcheli ShakhtoStroy attached to the Tkvarcheli Coal Mines Trust
  - c. The Akhaltsikhe ShakhtoStroy attached to the Akhaltsikhe Coal Mines Administration.

The further expansion of mines, maintenance, and repair was the responsibility of the coal mine trust to which a mine was subordinate; this was financed and accomplished through the respective trust's capital construction sections [redacted]
