The following information concerning the Rheinmetall-Borsig office machine plant in Sümmerda was received:

Machines, which had been rented from the American Hollerith Company at a monthly rental of RM. 10,000, were dismantled and shipped to Russia. There are indications that the Russians also plan to dismantle Powers machines in this plant. The Remington Company is reported to be concerned about these dismantlings.

Comment: The Hollerith Company is the German branch of the International Business Machines Corp., builders of the "Hollerith" tabulating machines. Powers is a British concern manufacturing office machines, also built under license by the American Remington Co.)
