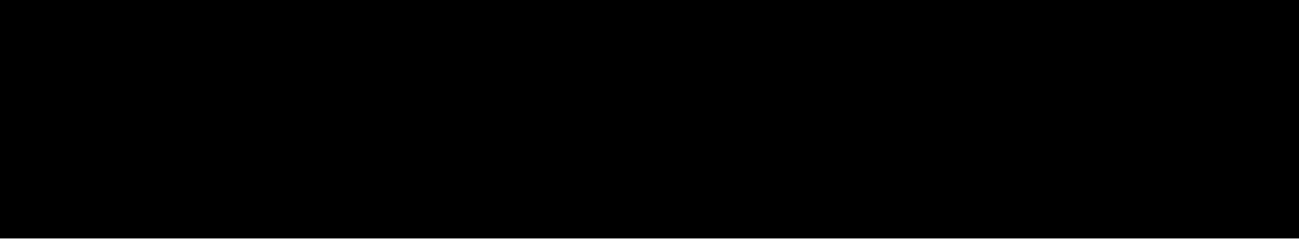

1. Rear-Admiral Szhtryer obtained certain additional - but unspecified - units for the Polish Navy during his visit to Moscow in early summer.
2. Seven minesweepers and five motor gun-boats, to be used for the training of Polish Naval personnel, have recently arrived in Gdynia.
3. Minesweeping in Polish waters is still being carried out by the Russians, as Polish crews are not yet ready. It is still dangerous to enter Gdynia, as little has been done in the way of minesweeping and removal of sunken vessels.
