Comment: Previously a rifle division had three Infantry Regiments and one Artillery Regiment. An AT Battalion and an AA Battalion were attached to the division Hq. A recent tendency, as illustrated in the present division, has been to unite these formations into an artillery brigade.)

6. History: The Division, under the 9th Guards Rifle Corps, was engaged against the Germans from Stalingrad until the capture of Berlin. After the end of the war the Division was stationed in Nordhausen and Bleicherode in Thuringia. When the 47th Army (Hq Halle a.O. Saale) was deactivated in January - February 1946, some of its units remained in Germany, and others, including the 9th Guards Rifle Corps and its components, among them the 75th Guards Rifle Division, were returned to the Zone of the Interior.

Title "Bachmach", for participation in the capture of that town.
