1. Foreign holdings in industries nationalized by the Yugoslav government are estimated by source at about two billion Swiss francs, of which about 450 million are held by Swiss nationals. Source does not believe that the owners will receive any substantial compensation.
2. A central office for electrical administration and planning throughout Yugoslavia has been opened at Zagreb under the designation ELPOCH. Centralization of the electrical industry presents a peculiarly difficult problem since it involves the coordination of hundreds of separate plants. The most important single project under consideration by ELPOCH is the construction of a Danube power plant at the Irongates, in accordance with detailed plans worked out by the Germans during the war and captured by the Yugoslavs. It is expected that funds originally intended for the reconstruction of Trieste harbor will be transferred to this project.
