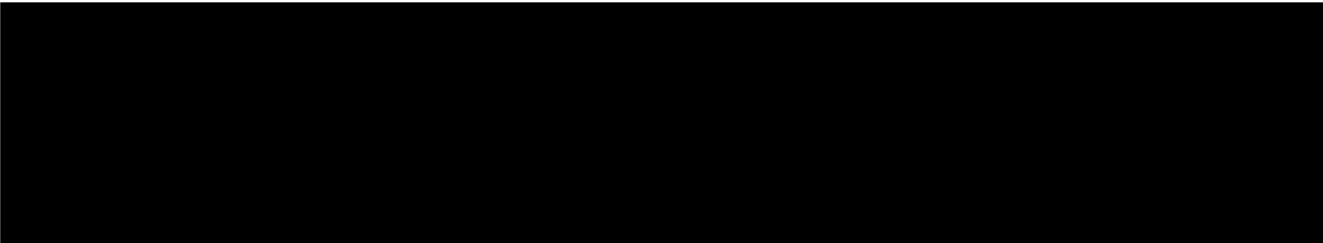

SUPPLEMENT



1. The following USSR-bound trains were observed on the Berlin freight ring, routed via Schönewalde and Tempelhof, early in October 1946:

2. There were also seven trainloads of cable-carrying drums, two meters in diameter and about one and a quarter meters wide, with telephone and telegraph ground cables (four to five centimeters in diameter). Each train consisted of 50 cars, each carrying three drums. No destination stated. Some drums bore the black-painted figure 150/3.
