

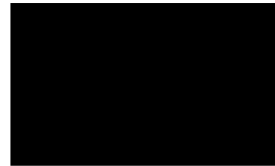

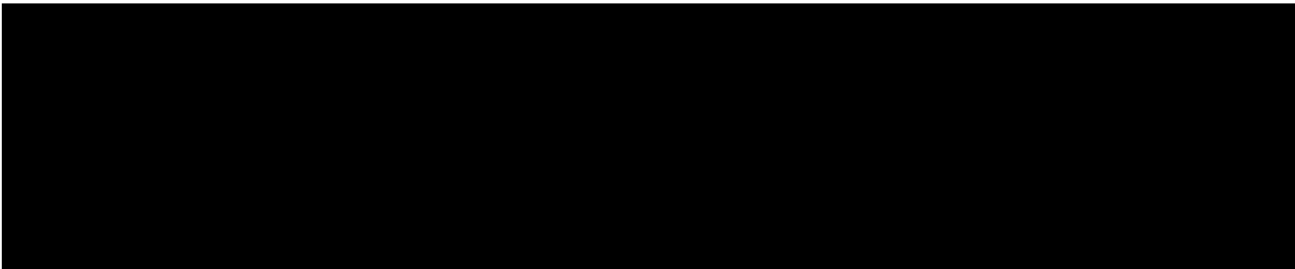

SUPPLEMENT



1. An unofficial meeting was held 4 January at Maliwan Palace in Bangkok attended by members of the Siamese government, members of the Free Laos movement, Annamites, Cambodians and a Burmese.
2. Dr. Hoang, the Annamite leader, stated a federation must be set up to serve as a buffer between India and China.
comment: Dr. Hoang is the assumed name of the former Annamite Governor of Cochin China in the interim period between the surrender of the Japanese and the arrival of British and French troops.)
3. Others attending the meeting were Assistant Minister of the Interior, Tiang Sirikhan, who organized the meeting; Minister of Industry, Thongin Phuriphat; Assistant Minister of Commerce, Chamlong Daoruang; Free Lac leader, Tao Don; Cambodian Prince Narodom Chantharangsi; an unidentified Burmese leader.
