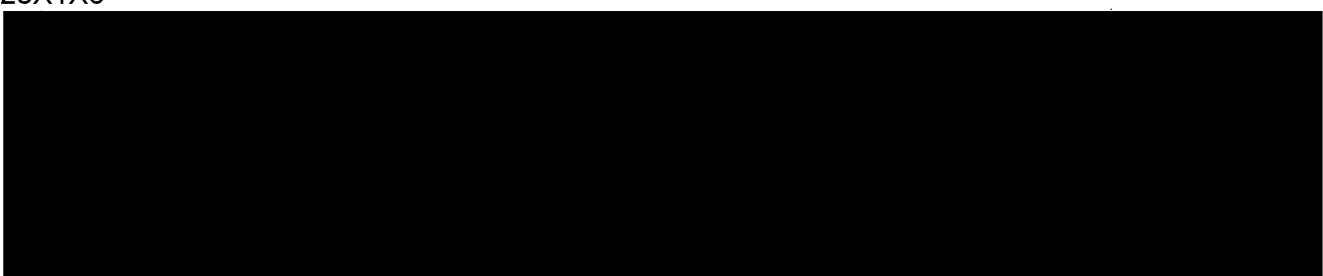

1. the Indonesian problem is of current concern to most Dutchmen. He doubts there are many Dutchmen who really like the basic "agreement" now under discussion, but does not personally feel it should be rejected. He believes it must be accepted in order to achieve a better agreement under which the Dutch can work with the Indonesians.

2. The chief concern of the Dutch is that the Indonesians may not have the ability or control to carry out that agreement. The states the constant violations of the truce are caused by the fact the Indonesians do not exercise control over their troops. He believes the time may come when the Dutch and a few loyal and disciplined Indonesian troops may have to fight the extremists together.
