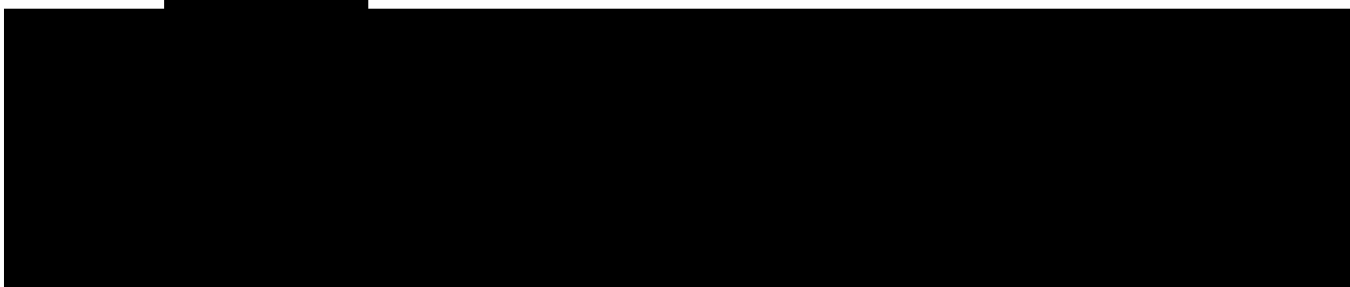

1. Source visited the airfields at Domzale (RD-4527), Brezice (RE-2302) and Krsko (RE-1409). He reports that German war prisoners are employed as chauffeurs, mechanics, and technical advisors. German pilots are now being considered for flight duty. While at Krsko, he saw Russian officers serving as pilots and was told that there were also Russian pilots at Domzale.
2. The Russians employ Yugoslav ground crews, supervised by Russian technicians, to service their planes.
