SOURCE

1. In Poznan are stationed 25,000 men, tank battalions, infantry, and motorized troops. General Remenkow is CG. Poles where men can apply for admission to the Communist Party have been set up. The membership card of the Communist Party entitles the holder to get cheaper food.
2. In Grudziadz (Grandenz) are stationed 12,000 men, consisting of engineering troops, infantry, and motorized troops. A hospital for venereal diseases has been established for soldiers from the Soviet Zone of Germany.
3. There are about 8,000 men in Ortowo, a small town on the coast. They include infantry, marines, and military police, mostly Polish volunteers, formerly German collaborators.
4. In Kartway (Karthaus) a force of about 10,000 men is permanently stationed. Barracks have been prepared and large barracks which could accomodate about 40,000 soldiers, with hospitals and casualty wards, have been built in the woods near the sea; here engineering troops drill with speed boats and practice camouflage and landing. Patrols are being sent out from there along the entire coast. These patrols of about 90 men consist of military police and engineering troops.
5. The MVD stationed in Gdansk reputedly sells documents and all other essentials for clandestine journeys through the country. The MVD Commissar in charge of the section from Orlewo to Gdansk supposedly is a Mr. Abramof, a Jew, who is in the good graces of Stalin; he is much hated by the Poles, since he is susceptible to large bribes.
6. Six thousand infantry and marines are stationed in Gdynia and the Hel peninsula. A Polish rear-admiral, supposedly in charge, is really subordinated to a MVD officer, a Jew, whose name is Adam Mohoczy.
