

- 1. Two partises brigades have been formed recently in Gorizia and are expected to be used as an eventual fifth column. The first brigade is under the command of Albino Marvin, son of Antonio, born in Gorisia on 10 February 1908 and there residing in Via Rastello \$14. He was a Major in the Spanish Loyalist Army and is now a Colonel ga the Yugorlav General Staff. He was absent for about 16 years and returned to Corizia in May 1945. The second brigade is under the command of Cirillo Budihma, who in turn is under the command of Marvim. Budihma is the son of Pietre Budihna and was bern in Mentespine on 26 February 1893. He lives in Gorizia in Via Veneto #45 and is a grocer by profession.
- 2. The total strength of the two brigades should not be more than 250 men. This number is expected to increase shortly as numerous Yugoslav soldiers, residing in the Gorisia area, are being demobilized and are expected to join these brigades.
- 3. The centers of these brigades are in Montespine, Fogliano, and S. Andrea. In S. Andrea there have recently been some night disturbances. The men were armed with either pistols or with guns and sub-machine guns. Their resting lace was half way between S. Andrea and Savonia, along the Isonso River.
