1. Defenses

- Battery of 105mm (Italian) guns
Strength: 40 men
Isola di Lacosta, height 101, N.W. of Porto Raso (Sheet No. Y 124 E6236)
- Five 105mm (Italian) guns
Four four-barrelled MGs
Strength: 60 men
South of Porto Raso, near signalling station on Shrizeva Point (Sheet No. Y 124 E6236)
- Six 105mm guns, six cannon guns
Strength: 60 men
Isolotto di Vrajinjotok (Sheet No. Y 123 E6429)
- Nine 105mm guns, twenty 20mm cannons. Unit of 260 men commanded by a Naval Lt. Col. and a Capt. Commissar
Kabala (Sheet No. Y 136 A7434)
- Six guns, four 20mm cannons
Strength: 130 men
Punta Ostro (Sheet No. Y 136 A7330). This area is used frequently for manoeuvres by the students at the school in Melijine (Sheet No. Y 136 A7436)

2. Dumps

- Small and large calibre ammunition stored in huts
Glagati (Sheet No. Y 136 M5971)
- Four storage tanks, above ground level and camouflaged, each tank containing 50,000 liters of diesel fuel
Lipci (Sheet No. Y 136 A8242)
- Cave about 300 meters from the left jetty of the port containing a gas dump
Lipci (Sheet No. Y 136 A8242)

3. Miscellaneous

- A repair shop for heavy and light weapons
Lepetane (Sheet No Y 136 A8539)
- Factories making boots, uniforms etc. for the service. There are also laundries and workshops making barracks material.
