Leaders of these alleged opposition parties will be former members of pre-war political parties who have since become members of the Communist Party or sympathetic toward the Tito Regime. 25X1 In line with this policy Slovene government officials have created a new Christian Socialist Party and have asked Dr. F. Snoj, former Slovenian Clerical member of the Yugoslav Government in-Exile, together with Dr. 25X1 F. Mosar to participate. Despite pressure on part of the government, either to collaborate with the government or go to prison, both of these men refused to join the new party. 25X1 3.
