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- 25X1 1. It is reported that the Central Administration of Industry has been asked to draw up a plan for allocating the following Red Army orders to factories in the Russian Zone:
- 2,000 artillery barrels, calibre 186 mm.
 - 180 gun turrets for twin mounting on ships
 - 500 tank turrets as spare parts for German tanks
 - 1,200 searchlight casings without mounts
 - 14,000 fruit tree sprays with jets for one-man flame throwers
 - 2,000 km. field cable
 - 18,000 iron trailer coupling pins
 - 800 welding units for repair trucks
 - 16,000 zinc fuel tanks, 200 liter capacity
 - 8,000 starter batteries for trucks
 - 4,000 sled mounts for heavy machine guns
 - 2,200 five-ton truck frames
2. The following Red Army orders have already been allocated and are to be filled by the dates indicated.
