1. Dr. Herold, formerly employed by the Leuna-Werk and taken to Russia in October 1946, wrote from Moscow in November. Frau Herold was invited to SMA Halle, where she was given the letter with much ceremony and asked to read it on the spot. The letter was then posted on a bulletin board.
2. Doctors Fischer, KENNIG, and Hauffe are [Redacted] among the specialists deported from the Buna-Werk in Schlegelau to the USSR.
3. Dr. Heil, resident of Dessau and perfums specialist at I.G. Farben, Bitterfeld, was forcibly deported to Russia.
4. Dr. Ostermann, deported from Berlin-Falkensee on 23 October 1946, is in a Moscow suburb and is giving daily lectures to a group of thirty Soviet "doctors" who speak fluent German.
5. Some Siemens specialists are at Kiev, apparently satisfied but bored while waiting to begin work in February 1947. The secretary of a former Siemens director has written from an unnamed location forty kilometers from Patum, and has referred to plane trips to Moscow on official business.
6. Former Telefunken specialists have written from Shepko<sup>(sic)</sup>, forty kilometers north of Moscow.
