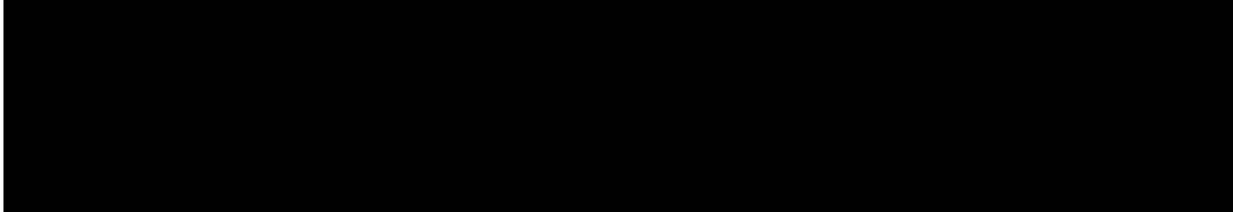

1. On 29 January 1947, eight hundred officers and men of the Russian 87th Infantry Regiment arrived in Skoplje from Odessa via Bulgaria. This regiment was based in Odessa.
2. It is said that these troops were being sent into the area to familiarise them with the terrain and for some type of special training. They were billeted in the Marshal Tito Barracks on the Vardar River in Skoplje. The liaison officer between the Russians and local authorities was Major Djordjevic, personal aide to General Renkovich, Chief of UDB.
