- Yugoslav economic penetration is infiltrating almost all circles of the economic and financial life of Trieste.

2. Commercial Activities:

All firms or shops which have a Slovene owner have already been organized and obey directives emanating from Yugoslavia. They draw their supplies from Yugoslavia. Since last May, 122 Slovene firms of all kinds applied for and obtained membership in the local chamber of commerce. While most of these firms have been formed by Yugoslav anti-Tito refugees, some are owned by strong pro-Tito supporters or are a cover for secret activities. Some propagandize among their customers and have almost the function of a Slav-Communist cell. (See Attachment A for the 122 firms.)

3. Food Supplies and Shops:

Up to a short time ago, most of the small food stores were owned by Slovenes and only a few Slovene firms had a greater importance in this field, such as Vadovec Princ. Lately, with ANO approval, the "Associazione Autonoma della Alimentazione" was formed which is ostensibly a labor union among small food handlers, but in reality has also a political function. The immediate goal is to supply all its members with goods coming from Yugoslavia, thus eliminating from the local market the larger Italian dealers and the small Italian shop owners. Leaders of said "Associazione" are: Boschetti, Piazza Garibaldi; Bertossi, Via Ginnastica; Gnitica, Via Cesare Battisti; Smuc, Via Cesare Battisti; Starchelj, Piazza Garibaldi; Berne, Via Manzoni; Paole Debellich, Piazza Tommazzo.

- The above-mentioned association is in close touch with the SITAC, Via Crispi No. 12, which is a similar organization but concerned with large scale buying and selling of alimentary products. In SITAC are included also fishhandlers and butchers (about 40) who are selling meat to the UAIS (Unione anti-Fascista Italo-Slovena) followers at a political price.

- An Associazione Economica Italiana di Trieste e Territorio has also been formed which is closely connected with the UAIS even though it has an Italian



name. It is supposed to perform union and welfare activities among local businessmen. The following categories have been asked to join: Businessmen of all kind, grocery woners, small food dealers, bakers, innkeepers, coal dealers, artisans, carpenters, fishdealers, and industrialists.

6. Contractors:

There are 14 new contractor firms which are either owned or controlled by Yugoslavs. These firms have been especially active in the reconstruction of villages of the Trieste area, under the AMG Public Works reconstruction program. Now they are trying to infiltrate the Trieste market but with little success, up to now, since the Italian contractors have better means, equipment and experience.

7. The local Prefecture authorities have been extremely careful in granting permissions to new Slovene firms. This difficulty is now being overcome by the Slovene firms, by using the name of an Italian as fictitious owner, while the Yugoslav elements have the functions of general managers or directors.

8. UIVOD:

The UIVOD (Uvozni Izvozni Zavod) has recently been importing into Trieste goods originating in foreign countries, without paying the required customs. This was done by importing the goods into Zone "B" and then into Zone "A", thus making them appear as goods originating in Zone "B", and therefore customs free. As an example, large quantities of dry fruits were recently sent from Czechoslovakia to Capodistria, and later imported into Zone "A" custom free, as a Zone "B" product. The UIVOD is also financing the buying of real estate by Yugoslavs. On 15 March the UIVOD changed into a corporation. Its president is Mr. Mario Kociancic, of Italian nationality, but of Slovene origin, while the general manager is Mr. Giovanni Pretnat, a Yugoslav national. Another manager is Mr. Feriancic, a leading figure of the local UAIS.

9. PROMTEX:

Another rather suspicious firm recently formed in Trieste (12 February 1947) is the PROMTEX concerned with import and export from and to all countries. Administrator of said firm is Mr. Arduino Schoen, while the administrators are Dr. Ivan Cok, Eng. Ivan Gercic, and Dr. Vladimir Turina. A great deal of activity has been noticed in the office of said firm, but no business transactions have as yet been concluded.

10. Financing:

The financing of the activities of most of the Slovene firms in Trieste is being handled by the Banca d'America ed Italia (a bank vaguely connected with the Giannini (A.P. Giannini not to be confused with Giannini of Uomo Qualunque) interest). Directors of said bank are Mr. Vincenzo Richieri, from Genoa, and Mr. Francesco Konesny, formerly director of the Zivnostenska Banca, who is suspected of being connected closely with the local Yugoslav interests.

11. Another source of income is the clearing with Yugoslavia, which is being handled by the Banca d'Italia. Somehow funds manage to be utilized for

local political purposes probably with the complicity of some functionaries of the bank.

12. Real Estate:

The buying of real estate by the Yugoslavs continues even though it has considerably decreased in the last two months. In this field also Italian cover names are being used in order to avoid opposition from the local Italians. It is estimated that Italian real estate property amounting to one billion lire has been bought by Yugoslavs in Trieste. Some Italian elements are helping these transactions, among whom Avv. Moscolin, who handled the selling of the building located in Via Battisti No. 2, where a branch office of the Belgrade National Bank will open shortly. In the same street Yugoslavs are trying to buy the Fenice Theater, the third largest in town, which would be used as a Slovène theater and for propaganda purposes. Among the other Italians who are favoring these transactions, are Dr. Mario Trausin, and the notaries Sandrin, Iviani, and Sandrinelli.
