1. The demolition of the former underground guided missile factory at Woffleben (D 03) was impending in mid-January.
2. In mid-January a train was stopped near Woffleben by the Russians, who forced all passengers to get out and to carry explosives into the tunnel entrances of this factory. The operation lasted six hours.
3. The factory in question is undoubtedly the Mittelbau Project B3a, an unfinished factory intended for Junkers Motoren Werk, which was temporarily used by Henschel for experimental production of "Schmetterling" and other guided missiles.
