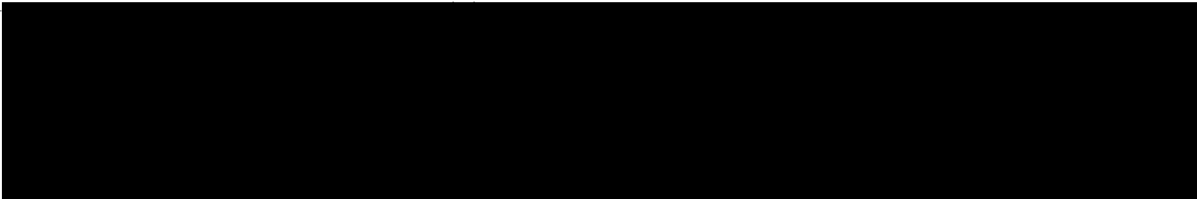

Source cites several occurrences as evidence of Communist infiltration in the government of the State of Sao Paulo:

1. Speech of Milton Caires de Brito, Sao Paulo Communist leader, before a meeting of Santos party leaders on 21 April 1947, expressing satisfaction with cooperativeness of Gov. Adhemar de Barros as well as with appointments of party members to police and municipal positions.
2. Appointment of Gomilde de Oliveira, militant Communist and longtime party member, to the detective force on recommendation of a friend of the governor.
3. Appointment of Joao Baptista Sales Pacheco, another Communist Party member, as chief clerk to the Chefe de Gabinete of the Secretary of Public Security.
