- 1. Two new mines are being developed about two kilometers northwest of Horní Slavkov (Schlaggenwald), at approximately P6184. Since Russians have been observed in this area, it is presumed that the mines may contain pitchblende.
- 2. Czechoslovak Army officers now employed on training problems at the military installations around Marianske Lazne (Marianbad, P56) are being subjected to extremely strict security controls.
