

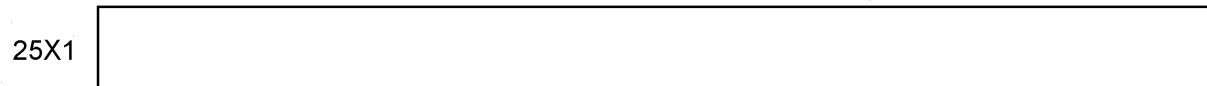

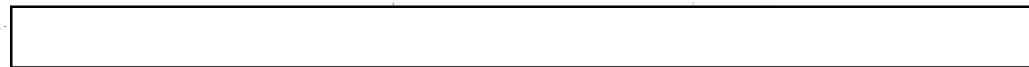

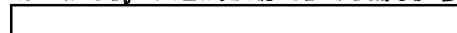

Bual Artillery Training Camp

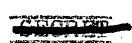
