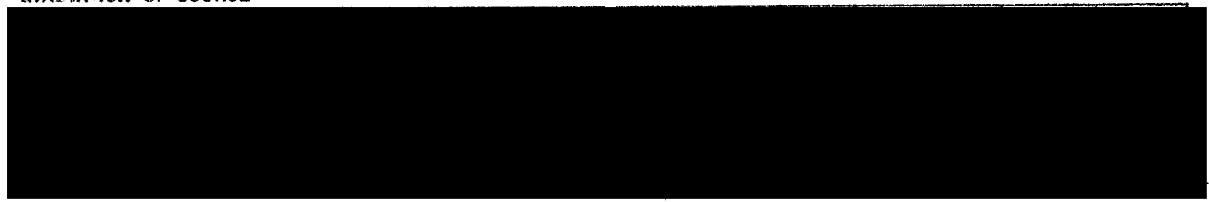

- 1. There are 130 male Japanese medical technicians, 520 women nurses, 150 male stretcher bearers retained in Harbin.
- 2. The Chungchang Railroad Office employs 250 Japanese technicians; the North eastern Railroad Office employs 970 Japanese technicians. 25X1A6a
- 3. 25X1A2g  
Note: See [REDACTED] for report on the Chungchang Railroad.
- 3. The Military Engineering Bureau has retained 550 Japanese. Of these about 155 are now working at the Tungan arsenal, and 270 are engaged in telegraph and telephone work; all are proficient and experienced mechanics. The remainder are ordinary workers.
- 4. The municipality of Harbin has retained 260 Japanese for work in the telegraph office and power plant.
