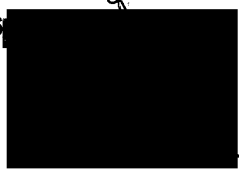

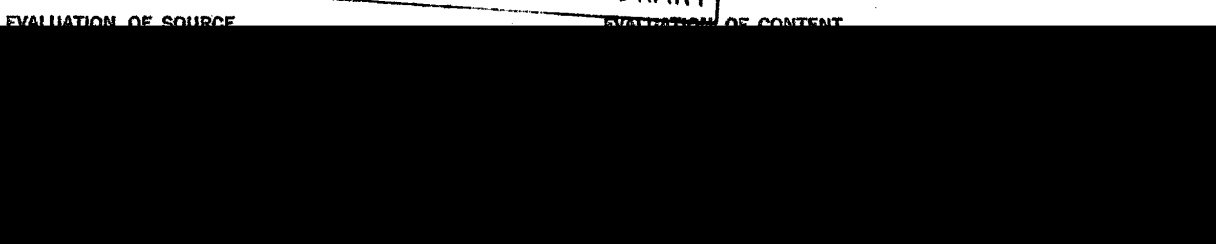

1. Two big sunflower seed oil refineries are located at Novi Vrbas (36/S7006). The factories - formerly the property of Volksdeutsche, and now nationalized are:

- a. "Domaca" Oil Refinery
- b. "Vojvodina" Refinery

2. Labor

Total labor employed in these plants is 800 workers, working a 52 hour week (48 hours paid and four hours "voluntary" unpaid). Pay varies from 100 to 120 Dinars per diem.

3. Production

During season total daily production of both refineries is approximately 30,000 liters refined oil.

4. Collection and Allocation

The "Zitopromet" (State Agency) is responsible for:

- a. the collection of all sunflower seed from farmers
- b. allocation of sunflower seed to refineries.

5. Distribution

Refined oil is distributed as follows:

- a. One-third export to USSR.
- b. One-third to Yugoslav Army.
- c. One-third to civil population.
