ORIGIN

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1. Work is in progress on the reconstruction of the normal gauge railroad between Borovo-Vukovar-Ilaca-Tovarnik.
2. The new railroad viaduct recently reconstructed at Prestrane is built of reinforced concrete. It is made up of seven arches, is 120 meters long and 18 meters maximum height.
3. The railway line between Klisura and Udovo, 14 kilometers long, has been completed. The construction of this line obviates the necessity of building two bridges (one near Klisura and the other near Udovo), which would have increased the vulnerability of the Skoplje - Salonica line.
4. On the Djerdjelija-Greek frontier line there are three railway bridges, between 20 and 25 meters long. Repairs on these bridges have not yet been completed, and in the meantime railway traffic is using temporary wooden bridges.

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
