1. [REDACTED] the Soviet Embassy in Buenos Aires has recently given financial aid to each of the following publishing houses:

Editorial Problemas,
Editorial Anteo, and
Editorial Amauta.

These subsidies were made through Luis Sosias Dalman, the Argentine representative of the Moscow agency Preslit, and director of the publishing house Ediciones Pueblos Unidos.

2. Soviet financial assistance has also been given to the Biblioteca Marxista, directed by Emilio Troise, for the publication of a History of the Communist Party of the USSR, written by the Central Committee of the Communist Party, a biography of Lenin Vladimir Ilich, written by the Marx-Engels-Lenin Institute of Moscow, and for publicity in connection with a biography of Stalin written by the same Institute.
3. The Soviet Embassy is expecting the arrival in the near future of a new representative for the Tass Agency, to replace Yuri Dashkevich, who left Buenos Aires in June 1947 as a result of pressure from the Federal Police. In the interim between Dashkevich's departure and the arrival of a new representative, details in connection with Tass have been handled by Igor K. Kolosowski, attache in the Soviet Embassy.
