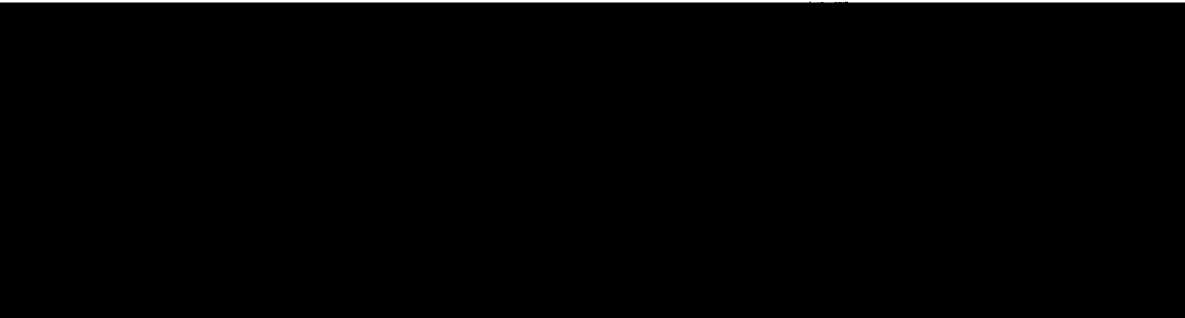

1. The Soviet Administration of Land Mecklenburg, located on Schlossstrasse, Schwerin, includes the following:

- Chief of SMA: Major General Trufanov
- Chief of SMA for Trade and Supply: Prilutski, civilian employee
- Chief of SMA for Agricultural Questions: Colonel Mikhailov
- Chief of the Political Section: Colonel Serrebrizski (Serebrenski)
- Chief of the Economics Section: Major Nebesni

2. Land Mecklenburg is divided into three Bezirks, each with a komendatura:

- Bezirk Wismar, including Kreis Schwerin, Hagemann, Ludwigslust, Schönberg, Wismar, and Parchim; komendatura headed by Colonel Niemkov
- Bezirk Güstrow, including Kreis Güstrow, Warren, Malchin, Rostock, and Neubrandenburg; komendatura headed by Colonel Balagesyan.
- Bezirk Greifswald, including Kreis Rügen, Stralsund, Uckermark, Grimmen, Greifswald, Anklam, Ueckermünde, and Demmin; komendatura headed by Colonel Kolesnikov.

3. There are Kreis komendatury to the strength of sixty to eighty men in the Kreis. The staff in Grimmen, for example, is composed as follows:

- Kreis Commandant, Lt. Colonel Fischenkov
- Deputy Commandant and Officer for Economic Questions, Lt. Colonel Shlikov
- Specialist for Economic Questions, Captain Mashkov
- Political Officers, Major Roshkov and Major Plienov
- School Questions, Lt. Colonel Saitzov
- Officer for Mobilization, 1st Lt. Davitic
- Financial Questions, 1st Lt. Bronosse

The former Kreis commandant, Lt. Colonel Ivanov, was recalled to Moscow because of fraudulent financial accounts and the scandalous conduct of his former political officer, Lt. Shukol. Although the present commandant arrived in Grimmen in February, Ivanov did not depart until 6 May 1947.

4. The Kreis komendatura of Schönberg, located in August-Bebel-Strasse, is commanded by Lt. Colonel Denilenkov. His staff includes 1st Lt. Ryabzhun, head of the political section, a professor of the Lenin School in Moscow, and Major Shorrin for agricultural questions. The Kreis MVD is commanded by Captain Suchenkov; its headquarters is the former police court in Amtsstrasse.
  5. The government of Land Mecklenburg is called Landesregierung Mecklenburg. It consists of the minister president and seven state ministries, bearing the designation Landesregierung des Staatsministeriums. Each ministry is designated as Landesregierung Mecklenburg, Ministerium für ... The minister-president and each state minister signs for his ministry with his name and office designation; the deputies of the president and ministers sign with the notation "Representing" (In Vertretung or IV); and all other signatories use the notation "By order of" (Im Auftrage or IA). The right to sign documents is established, according to the line laid down by the minister president, by each state minister for his own jurisdiction.

8. The Kreise together form District Councils (Kreistage) with fifty deputies and eight Kreisrats, of which the chairman is the Landrat. The seven additional Kreis Councillors are attached to the ministries representing Internal Administration, Culture and People's Education, Trade and Supply, Agriculture, Economy, Finance, and Social Welfare. These are constituted similarly throughout Land Mecklenburg.

9. The Landrat Offices follow a structural plan and have 227 personnel, divided as follows:
