It is reported that Utkin and Sagarin, respectively chief and deputy chief of the Light Industry Division of USIVA, have stated in a conversation that Major General Borisov will be replaced as head of USIVA around the third week in October. Mentioned as his successor was Malavin, head of the special Moscow committee which investigated USIVA in the summer of 1947. It is said that Borisov is not being removed for incompetence, but rather because of the fact that he is Jewish.
