1. Soviet-trained officers comprise the nucleus of three new columns now completing training in a camp south of Heihotun (127-31, 50-15). These officers were trained in Vladivostok in a special seven-month course sponsored by the Soviets. Trainees for the three new columns were drafted in the Heihotun area, beginning in July.

Source for Par. 2: Nationalist informant from Chiamussu area

11 September

2. It is reported that 300 Soviet-trained Chinese pilots have arrived in Chiamussu (130-21, 46-49).

The Soviets are giving the Communists 100 planes which will be delivered to Harbin this month.

Source for Par. 3: Nationalist Northeast Command Headquarters

13 September

3. 5,000 Koreans from Yenchi (129-31, 42-55) passed through Chiaoho (127-20, 43-43) enroute to Panshih (125-58, 42-56) and Hallung (125-48, 42-39) between 10 and 21 August.

Source for Par. 4: Nationalist informant, Harbin

12 September

4. 10,000 Korean troops arrived in Harbin from Suifenho (131-09, 44-23) between 16 and 26 August. The commander is KIM Ch'aek.

5. Between 26 August and 3 September a group of 6,000 unidentified Korean troops arrived in Antung. These troops carry Japanese M-38 rifles and wear yellow uniforms.
