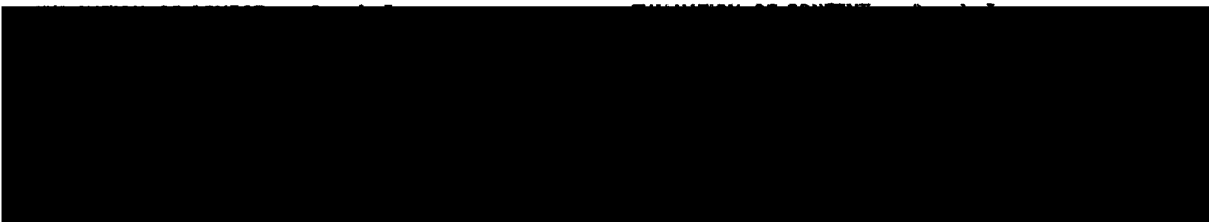

1. The Soviet 32 Mixed Air Division is at Sinuiju (Shingishu) (124-24, 40-06).
2. There are 140 model JK (?) and NY (?) airplanes at the Sinuiju Airfield. (Shanghai Note: SO-7587 reported 131 Soviet airplanes at the Sinuiju Airfield on 12 July.)

Aviation School in Sinuiju

3. There are 190 Korean students in an aviation school at Sinuiju. (Shanghai Note: SO-5782 reported that Soviet officers were giving flight instruction to Korean students at the Peace Preservation Corps Officers School at Sinuiju.)
4. The head of this school is YI Tok-in (李德林), who is also the leader of the Democratic Young Men's League (民主青年同盟) in Sinuiju.
5. In this school there are 19 Soviet, six Japanese and two Korean instructors.
