1. There do not appear to be any regularly constituted advisory boards composed of Germans attached to Gouvernement Militaire.
2. There are, however, Germans who are employed by Gouvernement Militaire as experts in certain fields. These include the following:
  - a. Alfred Döblin, a well known German writer, now a naturalized French citizen, who acts as German expert for the department of literature and schools.
  - b. Mr. Alfred Blum, who works as Gouvernement Militaire expert for legal affairs, in the newspaper and publication department.
  - c. Dr. Frey (or Frei), who works with Oficomex as expert on exportation of metal products.
  - d. Mr. Carlo Schmid, who advises Gouvernement Militaire on matters of constitutional law.
