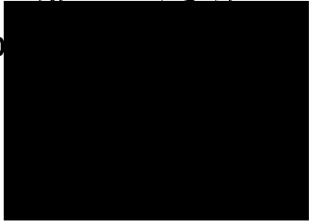
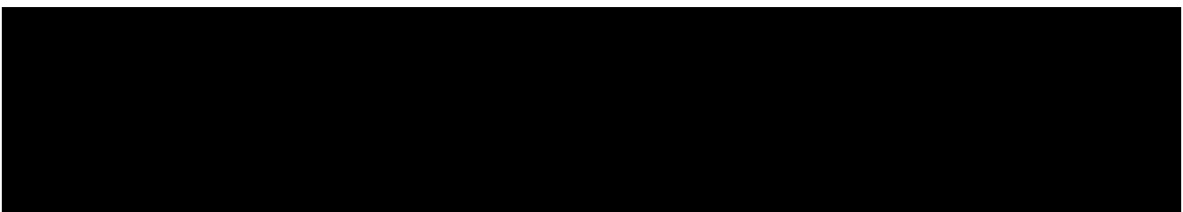

- In Songjin (Jowhin) (129-12, 40-40), there is a factory which is equipped with high frequency alternators and which produces aluminum and gun powder. [Redacted] Janis 75, Chapter VIII reports that the "Japan High Frequency Heavy Industry Company" and the "Kippon Magnesite (Chemical Industries Company) are in Songjin.)
- The factory covers an area of almost a square kilometer.
- The production of gun powder and aluminum at this factory is very low because of the removal of machinery by the Soviets. (the removal of machinery from this factory.) [Redacted] reports
- There are only 200 workers employed in this factory at the present time.
- Soviet soldiers are performing guard duties in the factory area.
