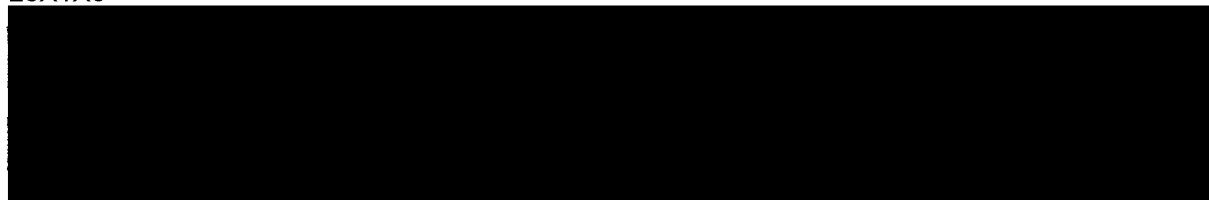

Lubomir Chasekiew, who left Argentina in April for Bulgaria after a long visit in Buenos Aires, is reported to be assisting in the building at Kostinbrod, near Sofia, of a powerful shortwave radio station. This station would be capable of maintaining permanent contact with Bulgarian organizations in South America.
2. Chasekiew is a construction engineer and a prominent Communist. His new undertaking, relayed by a source considered reliable, has been reported by the Hristo Botev (Cristo Boteff) Association, Bulgarian Communist group in Argentina.
3. The station reportedly being erected will be supplied power by two large generators and housed in a two-story building. This building will be surrounded by five housing units for personnel employed by the station and each unit will have facilities for thirty people.
4. Officials of the Hristo Botev Association in Argentina are said to be investigating the type of receiving and transmitting equipment required to communicate with the new station in Sofia.
